## ST. ANN FOOD PANTRY SUMMARY/UPDATE

APRIL 30, 2025

**BACKGROUND:** ST. ANN CATHOLIC CHURCH STARTED A FOOD PANTRY MORE THAN 2 DECADES AGO. IN EARLY 2016, AN INDEPENDENT 501C3 (BREAD OF LIFE) WAS ESTABLISHED TO OPERATE THE PARISH FOOD PANTRY. IT IS UNCLEAR AS TO WHY IT WAS THOUGHT NECESSARY TO CREATE AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY TO OPERATE THE PARISH'S FOOD PANTRY MINISTRY, AND THE WISDOM FROM WHICH THIS COURSE OF ACTION WAS CONCEIVED IS DEBATABLE.

**FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024:** THE PARISH DIRECTLY FUNDED THE 501C3 OVER \$20K IN PLANNED AND EMERGENCY SUPPORT. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE EXPENSES THAT WERE PAID BY THE PARISH ON BEHALF OF THE 501C3.

**SPRING 2024:** DUE TO THE ONGOING REQUESTS OF THE 501C3 FOR EMERGENCY FUNDING, I CONTACTED THE DIOCESE OF GRAND RAPIDS FINANCIAL SERVICES OFFICE TO REVIEW THE 501C3'S FISCAL PRACTICES. I ALSO REQUESTED A COPY OF THE 501C3'S FINANCIAL RECORDS. I WAS PRESENTED WITH ONE-SHEET OF HAND WRITTEN NOTES AND WAS INFORMED THAT THIS WAS THE EXTENT OF FISCAL YEAR FINANCIAL RECORD KEEPING.

**JULY 2024:** THE (THEN) LEADERSHIP OF THE 501C3 REFUSED TO COOPERATE WITH ANY FINANCIAL REVIEW CONDUCTED BY THE DIOCESE OF GRAND RAPIDS.

**LATE SUMMER 2024:** IN THE COURSE OF FACT-FINDING, I DISCOVERED THAT THE LEADERSHIP OF ST. ANN-ST. IGNATIUS PARISH & THE 501C3 DID NOT ESTABLISH A CUSTOMARY (& NECESSARY) USE AGREEMENT THAT WOULD DEFINE THE STANDARDS & EXPECTATIONS BY WHICH THE 501C3 WOULD BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PARISH FOOD PANTRY. FURTHER, IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE 501C3 HAD BEEN OPERATING WITHOUT ITS OWN PROPER LIABILITY INSURANCE SINCE 2016. THIS PUT BOTH THE 501C3 AND THE PARISH AT RISK.

**FALL 2024-WINTER 2025:** THE DIOCESE OF GRAND RAPIDS, IN COLLABORATION WITH ITS LEGAL COUNSEL, CRAFTED A USE AGREEMENT THAT WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE 501C3. THE USE AGREEMENT EXTENDS AN INVITATION TO THE 501C3 TO CONTINUE ITS OPERATION OF ST. ANN'S FOOD PANTRY WITHIN CLEARLY DEFINED PARAMETERS.

**\*NOTE WELL:** THE USE AGREEMENT STIPULATES THAT ST. ANN-ST. IGNATIUS PARISH WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL UTILITIES AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PARISH FOOD PANTRY WHICH IS A CHANGE FROM YEARS PAST AND WILL AMOUNT TO A NEW, SIGNIFICANT MONETARY COMMITMENT.

**MARCH 2025:** THE USE AGREEMENT WAS REFINED TO ADDRESS PARTICULAR QUESTIONS AND UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES.

**CURRENT DAY:** ACCEPTANCE OR REFUSAL OF THE USE AGREEMENT IS NOW BEING DEBATED BY THE 501C3 BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

**\*NOTE WELL:** ALL INTERESTED PARTIES SHOULD REST ASSURED THAT SHOULD THE 501C3 BOARD DECLINE TO ENTER INTO A USE AGREEMENT WITH ST. ANN-ST. IGNATIUS PARISH, THE PARISH WILL STILL CONTINUE ITS FOOD PANTRY MINISTRY WITHOUT THE 501C3'S ASSISTANCE.

## FROM POPE LEO XIV'S FIRST HOMILY (MAY 9, 2025)

HE THUS SHOWED US A MODEL OF HUMAN HOLINESS THAT WE CAN ALL IMITATE, TOGETHER WITH THE PROMISE OF AN ETERNAL DESTINY THAT TRANSCENDS ALL OUR LIMITS AND ABILITIES."
