Verse 19 (Vulgate & DR Translation)


¹⁹ *et ponam in eis signum et mittam ex eis qui salvati fuerint ad gentes in mari in Africa in Lydia tenentes sagittam in Italiam et Graeciam ad insulas longe ad eos qui non audierunt de me et non viderunt gloriam meam et adnuntiabunt gloriam meam gentibus*

And I will set a sign among them, and I will send of them that shall be saved, to the Gentiles into the sea, into Africa, and Lydia them that draw the bow: into Italy, and Greece, to the islands afar off, to them that have not heard of me, and have not seen my glory. Ver. 19. Sign; the cross, which Christ left to enlighten us, (Ezechiel ix.; St. Jerome; Worthington) or the gospel, with the power of working miracles. Some Jews shall be saved, and shall preach to others, as God's servants. — Sea. Hebrew, "Tharsis, to Phul in Thebais, Lud, (Ethiopians; Bochart) who were expert archers." Septuagint, "Mosoch." — Italy. Hebrew, "Thubal;" denoting Italy, Spain, Iberia, &c. — Greece. Hebrew, "Javan;" who peopled Ionia and the Archipelago. Islands, near Asia, (Calmet) and all distant places. (Parkhurst, p. 4.) (Haydock) — Men of all nations shall be converted, and brought by angels to the Church. (St. Jerome) (Worthington)


